Classroom Routine/Behavioral Expectations			
<b>Entering the Classroom</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-enter room quietly</li> <li>-be in seat when bell rings</li> <li>-sit in chairs</li> </ul>		
<b>Starting the Day</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-have comp. book, textbook, calculator, paper, and PENCIL out.</li> <li>-do warm up on board or grade assignment.</li> </ul>		
<b>Attention Signal</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-when teacher is standing in front and ask for your attention</li> <li>-stop what you are doing...all eyes on teacher</li> </ul>		
<b>Note taking time</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-use comp book for notes</li> <li>-label section of notes as on the board</li> <li>-do example problems in comp book</li> </ul>		
<b>Independent work time</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-get out clean sheet of paper</li> <li>-label in right hand corner: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Name</li> <li>Period</li> <li>Assignment</li> </ul> </li> <li>-work quietly</li> <li>-when done remain quiet so all students have quiet space to work in</li> </ul>		
<b>Asking for help</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-look at examples in text</li> <li>-review notes for the day</li> <li>-ask an elbow partner for help</li> <li>-raise your hand or come to teachers desk</li> </ul>		
<b>Turning in homework</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-assignments will be graded at the start of each period following the day it was assigned and turned into HW basket</li> <li>-any score less that 70% will require a redo, due the next day</li> <li>-late assignments will receive an automatic 10% score reduction</li> <li>-assignment more than 1 week late will receive a zero</li> </ul>		
<b>Test taking</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-have notes, calculator, &amp; pencil on desk. Clear off everything else</li> <li>-silent once test is given</li> <li>-turn test into test basket on desk</li> <li>-read or work on other work until end of testing time</li> </ul>
